Music Fellowship Committee Minutes

September 9, 2017

The Music Fellowship Committee convened its monthly meeting at 8:30 am. Present for the meeting were Barbara Jacobs, Angi Mahlendorf, Mike Schramm, Charles Hess, Pastor Barkley. Absent were Sarah Laetsch and Jann Blanchard.

Pastor Barkley opened the meeting with a small devotion for the committee. The Committee then prepared its monthly singing schedule for the month of October, 2017.

Pastor Barkley brought up information about the wreath sales and a business flyer he had about this activity. The committee at large said yes to the sale of wreaths, however, we will discuss this matter further in future meetings.

It was proposed to have a fall clean-up at the church. The date selected was Saturday, October 21, 2017, from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. It is important that we market this fall clean-up day. A list should be created of items that need to be done around the church.

Discussion about the fund-raising money thermometer for the church to see how we are doing on raising funds for the overall projects. Barbara will create the final thermometer and work with Pastor Barkley for the thermometer information. A letter was also discussed that would be sent out to the congregation from the Music Fellowship Committee encouraging congregational members to support the overall fund-raising campaign. It would be agreed that Charles would create a rough draft letter and float it to the other members of the committee for their approval – corrections or additions, etc. The letter will be included with the next monthly Green Sheet.

The Reformation Spaghetti Dinner. Preliminary discussion about possible music selections involving Martin Luther. Barbara will create a worksheet for the dinner. Pastor Barkley agreed to be “Chef Boyardee”.

Pastor Barkley asked that information be included in the Green Sheet regarding the church bells and what will occur with them during the roof repair and their ultimate re-installation at the church. Pastor’s concern was that people would be unaware of the bells. By putting it in the Green Sheet, the congregation would be informed.
